

# CDC Guidelines for COVID Exposure, Testing and When to Quarantine

### Who needs to quarantine?

Anyone who has been in close contact with someone who has COVID-19—excluding people who have had COVID-19 within the past 3 months.

Anyone who has previously tested positive and recovered from COVID-19 do not need to quarantine or get tested again for up to 3 months, as long as they do not develop symptoms again. People who develop symptoms again within 3 months of their first bout of COVID-19 may need to be tested again if there is no other cause identified for their symptoms.

#### What counts as close contact?

- •You were within 6 feet of someone who has COVID-19 for a total of 15 minutes or more
- •You provided care at home to someone who is sick with COVID-19
- •You had direct physical contact with the person (hugged or kissed them)
- You shared eating or drinking utensils
- •They sneezed, coughed, or somehow got respiratory droplets on you

#### Steps to take

Stay home and monitor your health:

- •Stay home for 14 days after your last contact with a person who has COVID-19
- Watch for fever (100.4∘F), cough, shortness of breath, or other symptoms of COVID-19
- •If possible, stay away from others, especially people who are at higher risk for getting very sick from COVID-19

#### If you think or you know you had COVID-19 and HAD symptoms:

# You can be around others after:

- 10 days since symptoms first appeared, and
- 24 hours with no fever, without the use of fever-reducing medications, and
- Other symptoms of COVID are improving\*

\*Loss of taste and smell may persist for weeks or months after recovery and need not delay the end of isolation.



# If you tested positive for COVID-19 but have had no symptoms:

# IF you continue to have no symptoms, you can be with others after:

- 10 days have passed since you had a positive viral test for COVID-19
- \*\*\*If you develop symptoms at any time in the 10-day period following the positive test, you would then quarantine for an additional 10 days, and
- Follow the additional guidelines above for a *positive test with symptoms*.

## Additional Important Info Regarding Test Results...

- \*\*\*You may test negative if the sample was collected EARLY in your infection and test positive later during this illness.
- This only means that you did not have COVID-19 at the time of testing or that your sample was collected too early in your infection.
- This does not mean you will not get sick.
- Even if you test negative, you still should take steps to protect yourself and others.
- If you have symptoms later, you may need another test to determine if you are infected with the virus that causes COVID-19.
